## Deadly I-15 crash in Davis County

**NORTH SALT LAKE, Utah** – A Salt Lake City woman was killed after her car drifted off I-15 Saturday and rolled.

Witnesses told Utah Highway Patrol troopers the woman's car drifted out of the right lane and hit a small ditch, causing the car to roll over.

The woman, 51-year-old Gillian Dickensen, of Salt Lake City, received critical injuries in the crash, during which she was partially ejected.

Dickensen was not wearing a seat belt.

Medical personnel performed lifesaving measures as she was transported to Intermountain Medical Center, where she was later pronounced dead.

No other vehicles were involved in the crash, which happened at 2:06 p.m. on northbound I-15 just before the I-215 merge. There were no skid marks, leading investigators to believe the woman hadn't tried to stop. The cause of the crash is still under investigation.

The right travel lane was closed about two hours and reopened at 4:20 p.m.
