## **DIRECTIONS TO THE FIRE ACADEMY**

Take the **West Provo Center Street Exit** on I-15 and proceed approximately two miles west on Center Street toward Utah Lake State Park. Make a left turn on 3110 West at the street that takes you to the Provo Airport. Watch the signs. You will see two signs telling you to turn left. One is for the Provo Airport and the other is for the Utah Fire & Rescue Academy. Proceed south on the airport road until you near the entrance of the Provo Airport. As you approach the airport you will reach a bend in the road that turns the road direction from south to southwest. The Utah Fire & Rescue Academy is just south of that bend in the road and is a grey cinder block building.
