

## 2009 ALCOHOL RELATED FATALITIES & DUI (DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE) FACTS

- ▶ In 2009, there were 243 fatalities in Utah with \*\*23 of those fatalities being alcohol related
- ▶ In 2009, there were 15,226 DUI arrests, 2008, there were 15,619 DUI arrests; and in 2007 there were 15,070;

- ▶ Sheriff's Offices made 16% (2,391) of the DUI arrests in 2009, the Highway Patrol 31% (4,777), and City or Other Police 53% (8,058)
- ▶ 11,468 males were arrested for DUI, 3,691 females and 67 unspecified
- ▶ Average BAC of those arrested was .14% every year 1999 through 2009
- ▶ The highest rate of total DUI arrests occurred in the month of May with 1,408 arrests
- ▶ There were 861 (Not-a-Drop) arrests for youth offenders under the age of 21 years
- ▶ 23 Commercial Driver License DUI Arrests
- ▶ In 2009, DUI arrests by age were as follows:
