


STATE OF UTAH SITUATION REPORT

Significant State Activity

Immediate Concerns

- Active A Flood Warning remains in effect for the Bear River from Woodruff Narrows northward to the Utah/Wyoming state line. See Flood Warnings here [NWS SLC]
- Active Snowmelt due to warm temperatures and upstream dam releases will continue to result in increased river flows. Some
 reported flood-related landslides are being monitored.

Current State (SERT) Actions

Active Activated Emergency Support Functions: ESF #1, ESF #3, ESF #5, ESF #7, ESF #11, ESF #13, ESF #14, ESF #15, ESF #16, Logistics, VDCT, Volunteer Agency Liaison (VAL), Finance, and Air Operations.

Current Operational Requests

• Active 11 active requests are in progress regarding various flood response and mitigation resources. 79 requests have been closed. [WebEOC]

Region 1

Cache County

 Active Logan City has issued an <u>Executive Order</u> that limits recreation on the Logan River until 6/24/23 or the Mayor terminates the order. [LNO Correspondence]

Region 2

Salt Lake County

• Active SR-190 and SR-210 are being monitored and assessed daily to determine if/when road closures are needed for land/mudslides, avalanches, or other hazards. Closures are possible at any time. [UDOT Cottonwood Canyons]

Summit County

• Active The culverts near Old Ranch Road are at maximum capacity. The County's sandbagging efforts are holding. [LNO Correspondence]

Utah County

- Active A section of Nebo Loop Scenic Road in Payson Canyon has been washed out and will be closed until further notice. The County has been assessing and tracking the damages. Spanish Fork Ranger District Nebo Loop Scenic Byway is closed to all pedestrian, equestrian, bicycle, and all motorized vehicles from Maple Lake gate to Blackhawk Campground gate. Closure is in place for public safety due to road damage and while crews are repairing the road. [LNO Correspondence, Uintah-Wasatch-Cache USDA Forest Service]
- Update/Final Damages are ongoing with the sinkhole forming at American Fork Boat Harbor. American Fork City is working in conjunction with Utah County Emergency Management to address the concern. [LNO Correspondence]
- Active As of 4/6/23, there has been a <u>public notice</u> to boil water in Vivian Park due to storage tank damage caused by an avalanche on 3/23/23. [DEQ Correspondence]

Region 3

• No significant updates to report at this time.

Region 5

Duchesne County

• Active Duchesne River is near flood stage. [LNO Correspondence, Great Basin River Forecast]

Uintah County

- Active A brief uptick in the Green River near Jensen will be possible later in the week due to reservoir releases. [NWS Grand Junction]
- Active Ashley Creek is running at full capacity. [LNO Correspondence]
